## Electrolyte Problems

## **Inpatient**

- New hyponatremia < 130</li>
- Hyponatremia < 135 with altered mental status, seizures, or severe medical etiology
- Hypernatremia > 155
- Hypernatremia > 150 with altered mental status, seizures, severe medical etiology
- Hypokalemia < 2.5 DESPITE OUTPATIENT TX</li>
- Hypokalemia < 3.0 with significant symptoms</li>
- Hyperkalemia > 6.5
- Hyperkalemia > 5 with:
  - Severe ECG findings (NOT just peaked T waves)
  - Acute worsening of renal failure
  - Severe weakness
  - Severe medical etiology
- Hypercalcemia > 14
- Hypercalcemia > 12 with severe dehydration, AKI, hemodynamic instability, symptoms
