SUMMARY

Effective June 18, 2022, the CDC has recommended that everyone ages 6 months and older in the United States should receive a COVID-19 primary series vaccination for the prevention of COVID-19. As you know, vaccination is a powerful and important tool in combatting the COVID pandemic and ensure the health and safety of our communities. This Provider Webinar will offer a high-level summary of the most recent changes to COVID vaccine authorization through the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), share details regarding the vaccine options for various age groups, and offer resources that will support your role in administering the COVID vaccine to your patient population.
