- In Basket has a sleeker, cleaner look. With new designs for the home screen, message list and more, the whole activity has been optimized to better fit your workflows and preferences. For example, now it's easier to check your message counts at a glance, and quickly act on them using buttons and QuickActions in the message toolbar.

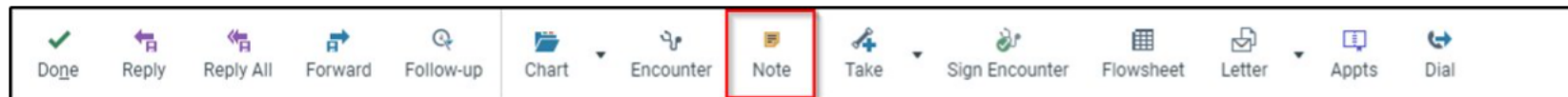

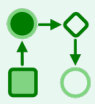

Review In Basket Conversations From Chart Review

Review In Basket conversations directly from the encounter summary report in a patient's chart. To make a message viewable in the encounter summary report, use the **Reply** and **Forward** buttons, where floppy disk icons and banners let you know whether your message will be saved to the patient's chart. Click **Note** (formerly QuickNote) if you want the message to be viewable from the Notes tab of Chart Review.



- The **Routing Comments** field is now collapsed if no text is entered to save space.

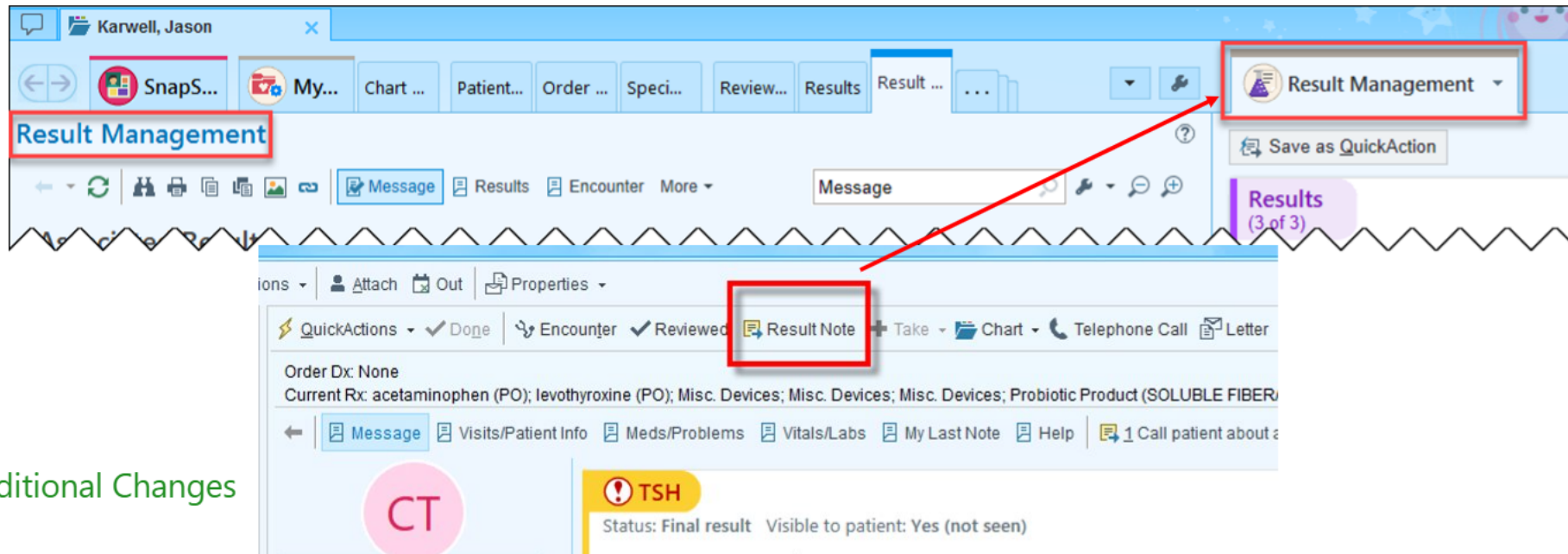

Result Note Is Now Result Management



The **Medication & Orders** navigator section is now named **Medication Management** to better reflect the task you commonly complete in this section now that you enter orders in the Visit Taskbar.

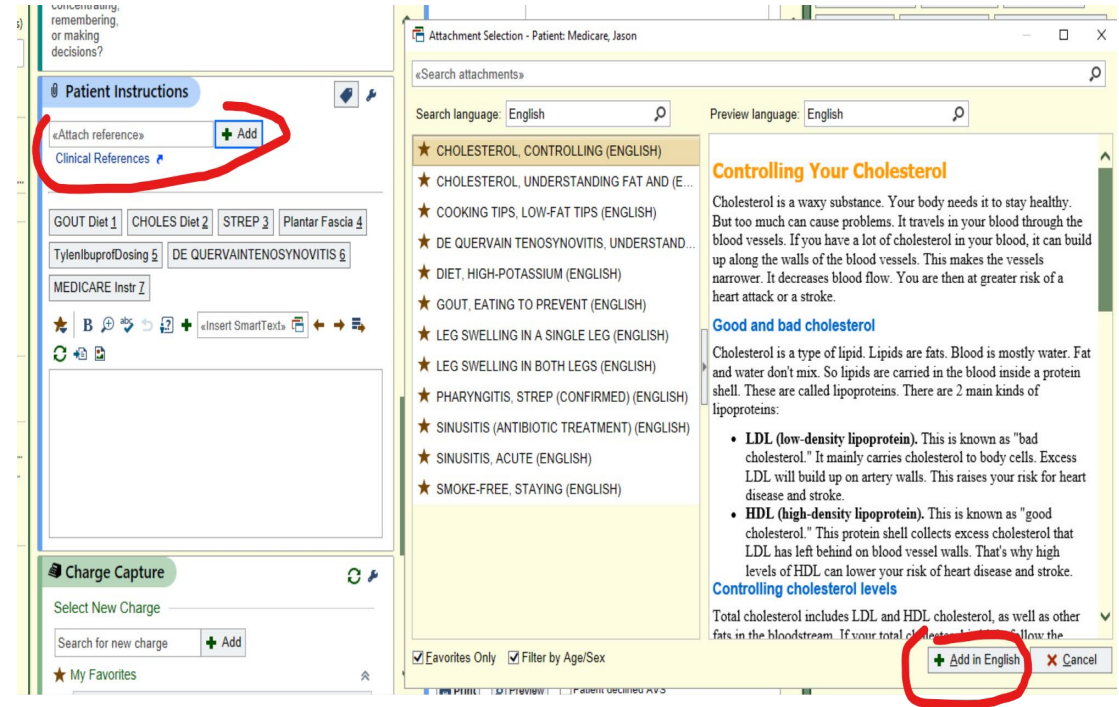
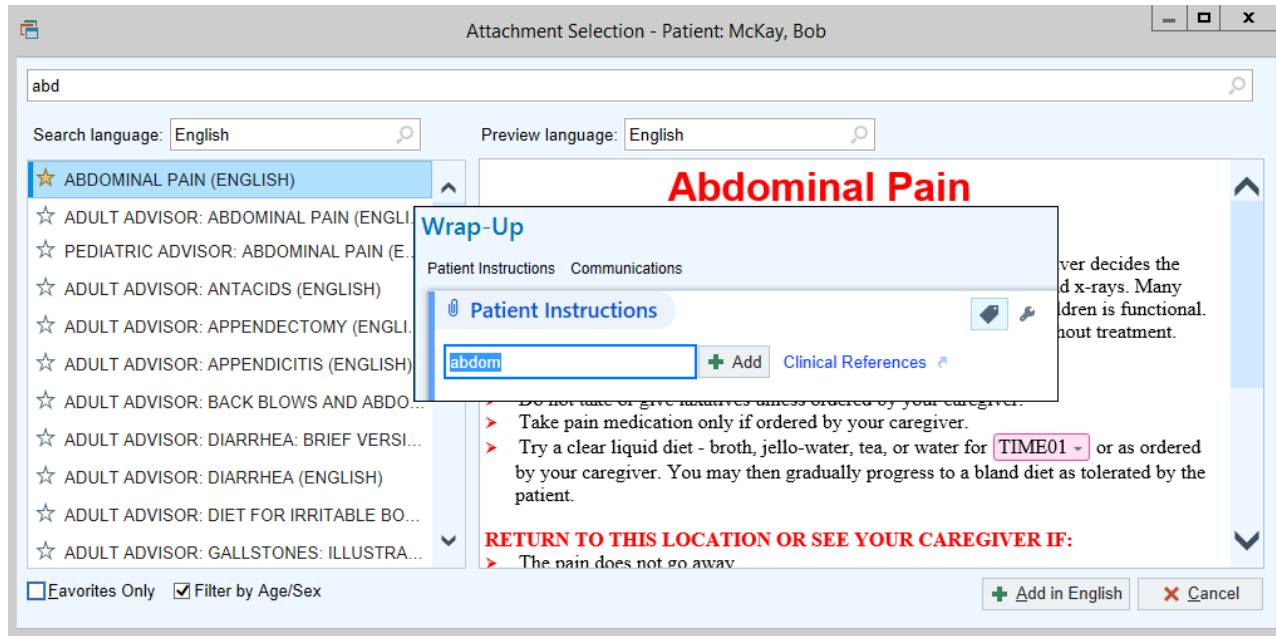



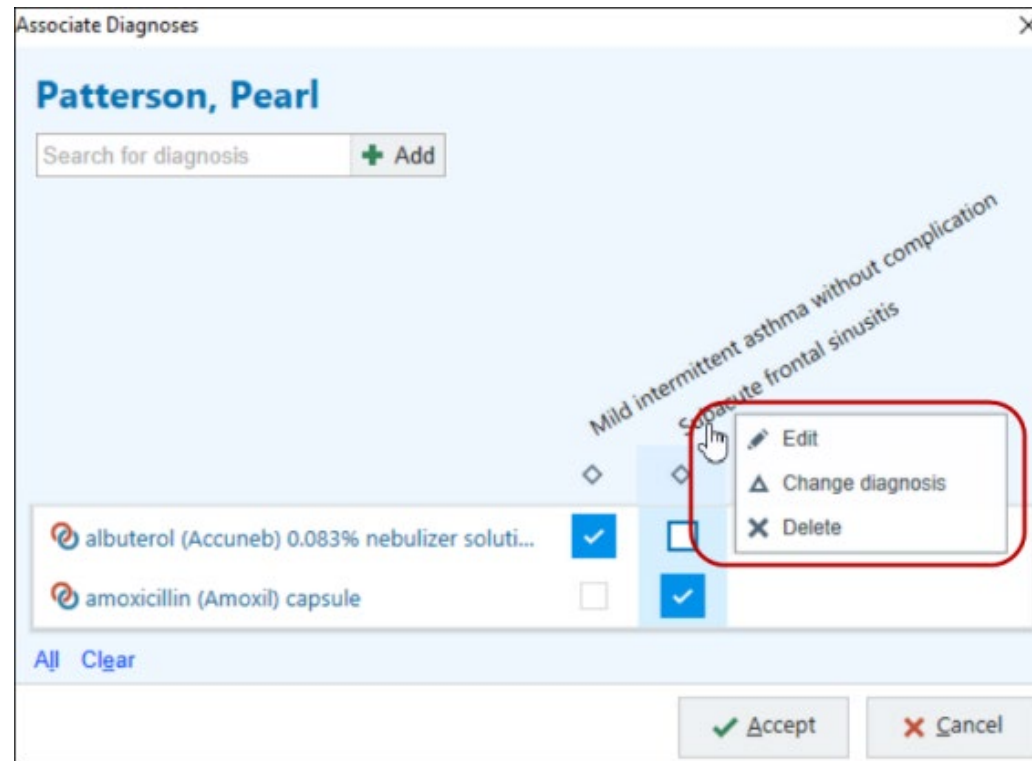
