TogetherCare patient wristbands are to be used for scanning. The reason for scanning will determine which barcode should be used. This tip sheet will help you determine which barcode should be used for each scenario.

Try It Out

- 1. CSN: The CSN barcode is the patient identifier and should be used for Medication, Blood Administration, and Specimen Collection.
- 2. MRN: The MRN barcode should be used by Blood Bank and WellSky Users .
- 3. Linear CSN: The Linear barcode should be used for Point of Care Device Scanning.
