Section I

Address Expiring Orders

To address an expiring order, click one of the following buttons:

- Renew: Extend the order.
 - Note: You can't renew blood transfusions.
- Reorder: Extend a continuous medication or procedure that has already expired.
- Let Expire: Inform other clinicians that you don't intend to renew or reorder. A note appears with your name, the date, and the time.

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- Modify: Change the order details.
- Discontinue: Stop the order now.

NOTE: Instead of renewing, you could let the order expire and write a new order. However, renewing saves you a few clicks. Also, renewed orders don't require pharmacy verification, so medications appear in the ADS sooner. Reordering requires pharmacy verification, but still saves you clicks.
